Suggesting that the Caregiver, staying home with the child(ren) after a parent has deployed, not hide their tears from the child(ren). Let them know, "I'm not doing so well with your mom being gone." or "I'm missing your dad a little extra today." The child is likely to respond, "So am I." And there's a good chance you may have relieved a heavy load from their shoulders... where they thought they couldn't express it because felt they had to show they were keeping it together like you were.

Children mimic and mirror adults. They take their emotional ques from you. There's a good chance they'll even repeat the reassuring words you've used with them, "Hey. We've got each other. We're going to pull through this together."
